Residents of Northampton are being urged to take action as the number of cases has risen above the national rate. We all need to work together to prevent a local lockdown.

Please follow these simple steps to help prevent us from having to reduce our services further:-

- We are open but general practice is NOT back to normal

### <u>The practice is currently in the preliminary stages of organising this years</u> <u>Flu Vaccination Programme.</u>

Due to social distancing guidelines we need to space out the flu clinics. This means it will take longer to vaccinate all of the patients who are eligible. In order to maximise the impact of the vaccination, we want to vaccinate patients as early in the flu campaign as possible.

As you can imagine this is going to require a significant amount of organisation and we will have to utilise the building in a different way to ensure we adhere to all the Government Guidance in light of COVID-19. This is to protect you and our staff delivering the vaccinations and the support staff required to ensure the clinics run as smoothly as possible.

We will releasing a Newsletter in the coming weeks which will detail specifically the measures the practice has put in place, time frames for the vaccination of the different patient groups and clear instructions on how, the patient, can assist in this process.

We will have marshals in place to direct you and our PPG will also be supporting us in this initiative.
